“We got to have this experience together! We would never get the chance to go on holiday with our best friends normally. It was perfect!”



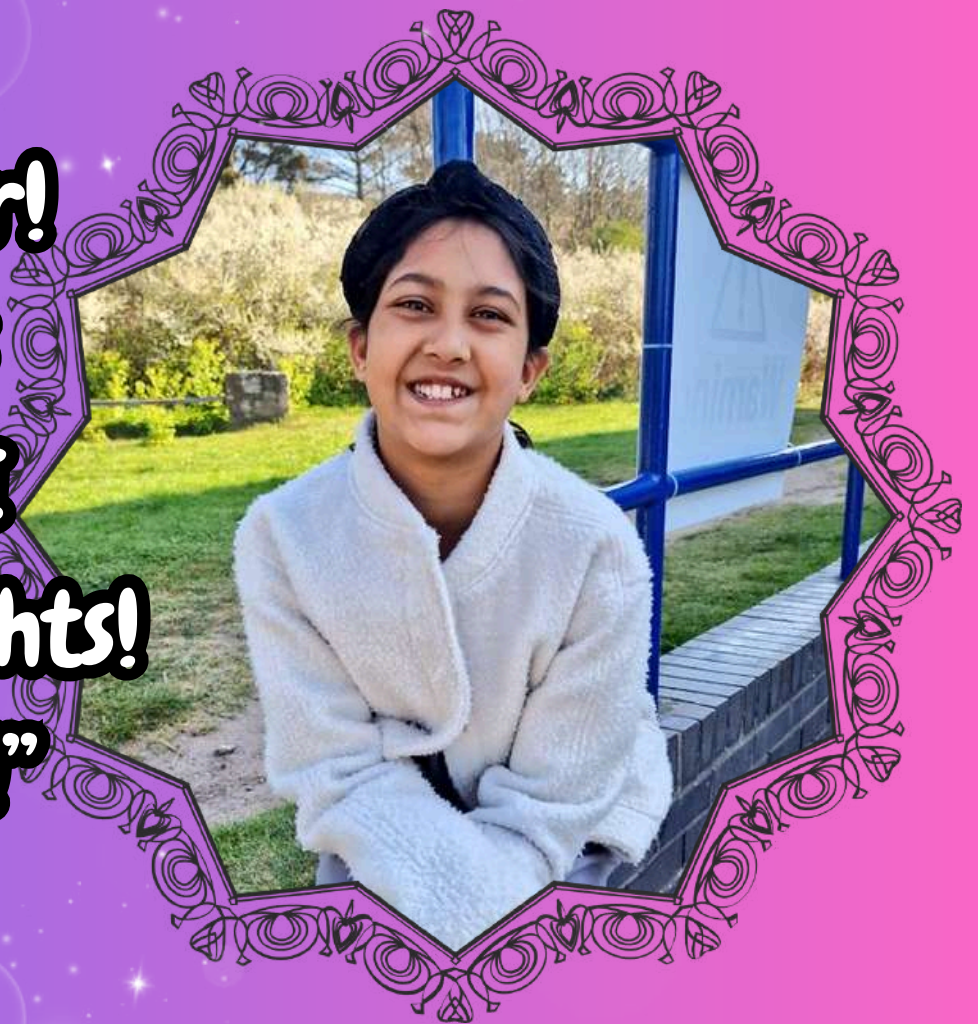
“I got to spend time with my friends on the beach, out in the sunshine! I never get to do that, so it was the best week ever!”

“I’ve never been away from home before so it was amazing to share a room with my best friends! I got to spend relaxing time with my friends too. It was great!”



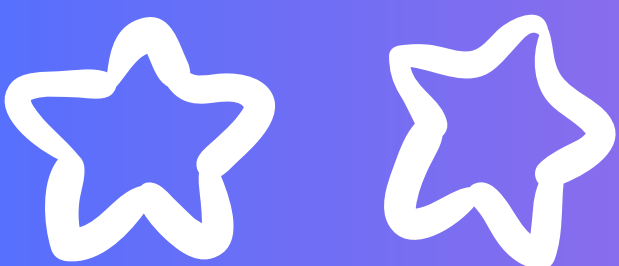

“I learned a new skill – Map Reading! I can take that with me now when I move to big school. I loved searching the rock pools for treasure!”



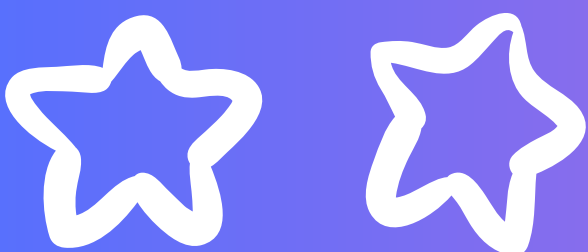


“The walk up to Culver Hole was really scary but really exciting! I have a fear of heights, but I overcame that on this trip!”
