“I really enjoyed the food! But most of all I enjoyed being with everyone, all together. We came together as a team to build campfires and buggies!”

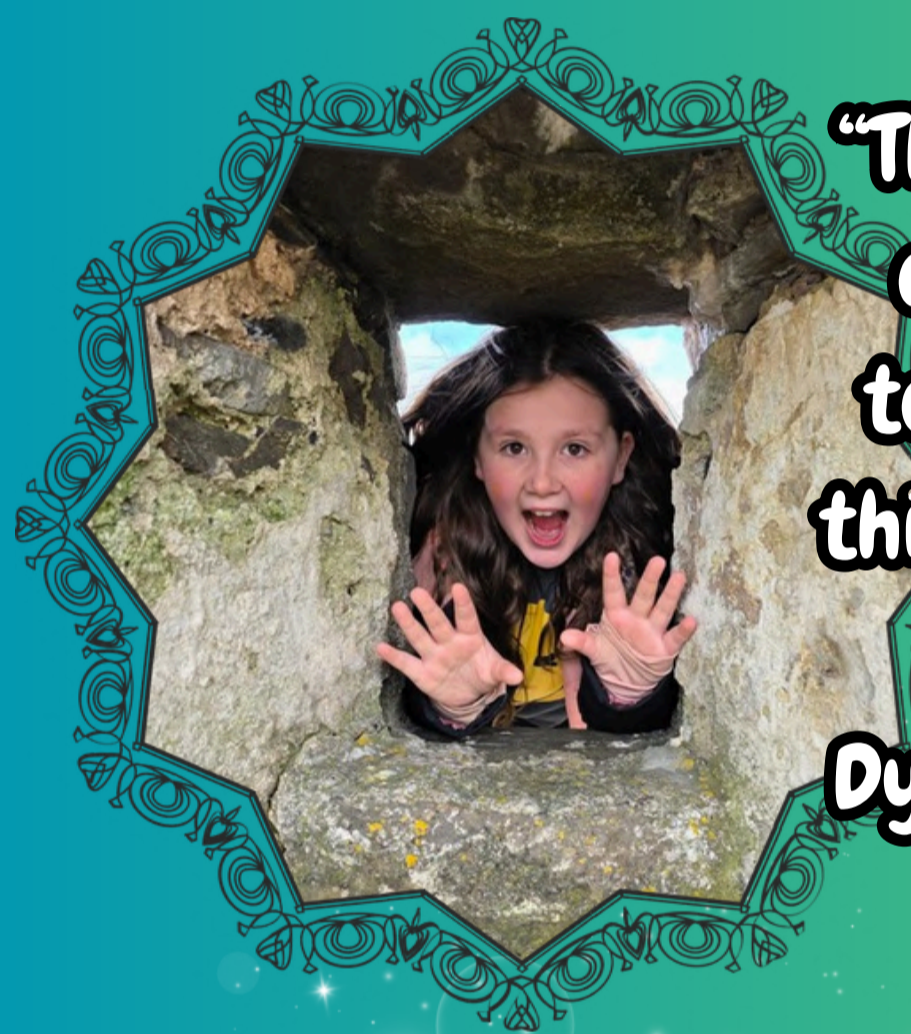


“We thought the campfire session was really fun, we learned so many new skills! And we worked hard together to build buggies! It’s so much better when we get to work together!”

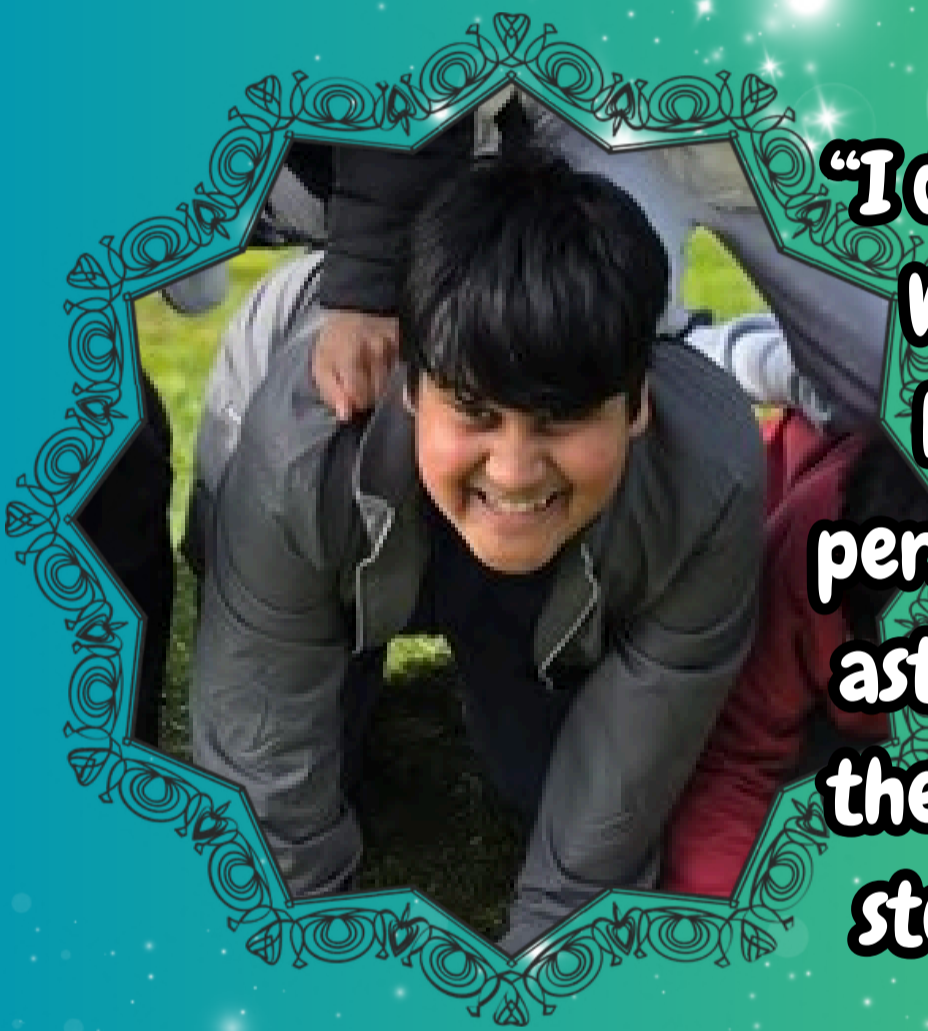
“The whole experience was life changing, and I loved being together with my friends for things like movie night! Without the donation from the Dy’vorians I wouldn’t have had this experience!”

“We’ve never been away from home before and this was so good for our confidence. We all got so much closer. We would have stayed at Borfa for two weeks instead of two nights!”



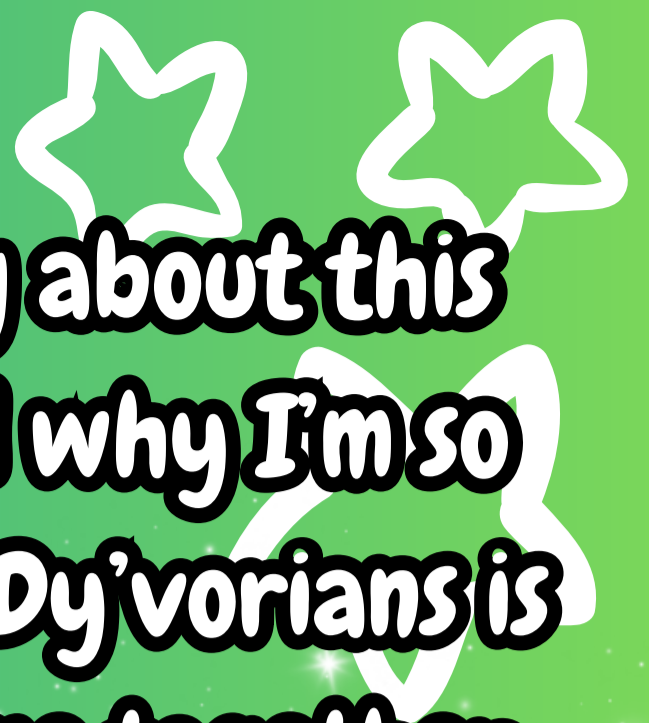
